

Courtesy Rules

- ◆ Please be ready when the bus arrives.
- ◆ The bus can only wait no longer than 2 minutes
- ◆ No Smoking.
- ◆ No Eating or Drinking.
- ◆ The driver is not allowed to enter your home.
- ◆ If you no longer need a ride, call the exchange and cancel.
- ◆ Wheelchairs must be equipped with working and locking brakes.
- ◆ All Passengers must wear seat belts at all times while riding the bus.
- ◆ All calls for pick-up/drop/off must go through the exchange service.
- ◆ No animals permitted except for service dogs.
- ◆ Driver is not responsible for items left on the bus.

What is the Senior Citizen Bus?

The Senior Citizen Bus serves residents of Oakhurst, Bass Lake, Coarsegold and Ahwahnee. The purpose of the bus is to provide transportation to medical appointments, senior centers for activities and nutrition programs, shopping and to various businesses in Eastern Madera County for senior citizens 60 years and older and disabled individuals. The bus is wheelchair lift equipped.

Who Can Ride ?

Senior Citizens and Disabled individuals only.

How to Apply ?

You must complete an application.

You can request an application by mail, from the senior bus driver or you can walk into our office to pick up an application.
