

## Courtesy Rules

- ◆ Reservations (pick up and drop off) must be made through the dispatcher.
- ◆ Please be ready when the van arrives as the driver can wait no longer than two minutes.
- ◆ No smoking, eating or drinking is allowed while on board.
- ◆ The driver is not permitted to enter your home.
- ◆ If service is no longer needed, please call the dispatcher to cancel your ride.
- ◆ Wheelchairs and mobility chairs must be equipped with working and locking brakes.
- ◆ Passengers must wear seat belts at all times.
- ◆ Only trained service animals are permitted.
- ◆ A maximum of three shopping bags is allowed.
- ◆ The driver is not responsible for items left on the van.

## Who Can Ride?

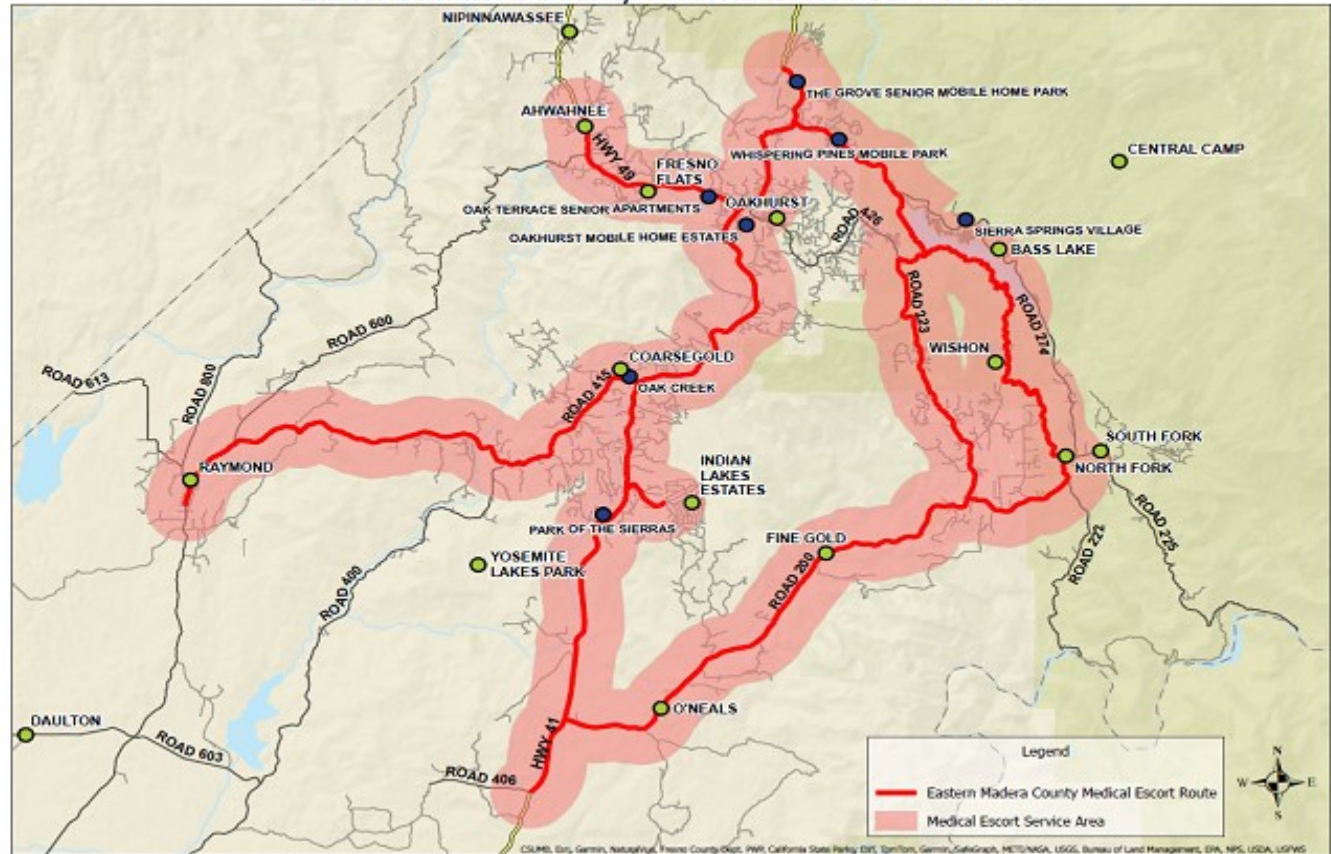
Individuals who live in Eastern Madera County may ride. Children under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.

## How Can I Get a Ride?

A reservation can be made by calling the dispatcher at **(559) 263-8080** to request a ride 24-hours in advance. Medical appointments must be scheduled in the morning.

There may be times when the driver must cancel your ride due to adverse weather conditions. Passengers who are scheduled to ride will be contacted as soon as the cancellation is determined.
